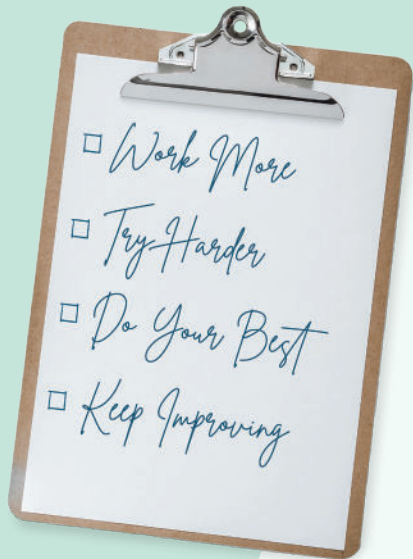


How do you know if you've done *enough*?



**“Be ye therefore perfect,
even as your Father

perfect.”**

MATTHEW 5:48

WHY WOULD GOD GIVE US A COMMAND WE COULDN'T KEEP?
“THE LAW WAS PUT IN CHARGE TO LEAD US TO CHRIST” (GALATIANS 3:24).

Jesus states not one command can be set aside. We are accountable even for our thoughts and words. **Jesus demands absolute perfection.**

To the surprise of many, Jesus never says, “Try,” “Improve,” “Do your best,” or “Be perfect eventually.” He says, “Be” right now.

Jesus doesn't tell us to be better than others or be better than yesterday. **The comparison he makes is “as your Father...is perfect.”**
